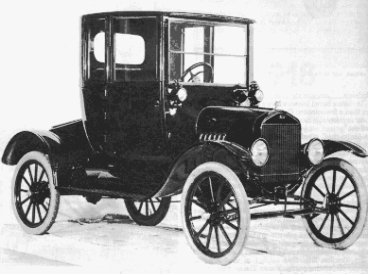


1920's Big Ideas
