
## **Dred Scott Political Cartoon**

This political cartoon is entitled "The Political Quadrille: Music by Dred Scott". It depicts Dred Scott playing the fiddle with the 4 presidential candidates of 1860, just before the Civil War. The creator was Rickey, Mallory and Company in 1860. Figures left to right clockwise: John C. Breckinridge dances with James Buchanan. Dred Scott seated plays the violin. Lincoln dances with African American woman. John Bell dances with Native American. Stephen Douglas dances with a sovereign in rags.

1. Explain 3 different racist/prejudiced images you see in this cartoon.

2. What is President Lincoln doing in this cartoon? What is the artist's message with this?
3. Describe the type of person who you think drew this cartoon? What is his or her bias?
