





 BACKGROUND: The Freedmen's Bureau was established to help poor Americans, specifically freed African Americans. The agency was funded by the government with taxpayer money and provided food, shelter, education, and other vital services.

ANALYSIS: "The Freedman's Bureau! An agency to keep the Negro in idleness (doing nothing) at the expense of the white man."

Why does the author believe the Freedmen's Bureau is responsible for creating idle "Negros?"

 Looking over the flier, how else does the author try to convince the reader that the Freedman's Bureau only creates idle "Negros"?

2.	BACKGROUND: President Lincoln supported the Freedmen's Bureau and signed it into law when Congress created the bill. When Lincoln was assassinated in 1865, Vice President Andrew Johnson
	became President. Johnson did not believe poor African Americans should receive handouts and vetoed the Freedmen's Bureau. Congress then overrode the President's veto ensuring the bureau remained active.
	ANALYSIS: "Support Congress & you support the Negro. Sustain the President & you protect the white man." Who does the author support in this flier? Why?
3.	IN YOUR OPINION: Choose one and explain your answer.
	 AGAINST THE FREEDMEN'S BUREAU: Do you think the author has a valid point that only taxpaying citizens should receive benefits from the government (therefore freed slaves shoul receive nothing)? OR FOR THE FREEDMEN'S BUREAU: Do you think African Americans are owed these services by the government since they worked for many years without receiving a paycheck? OR A LITTLE OF BOTH: Do you think the answer is a combination of both?
