Overview:

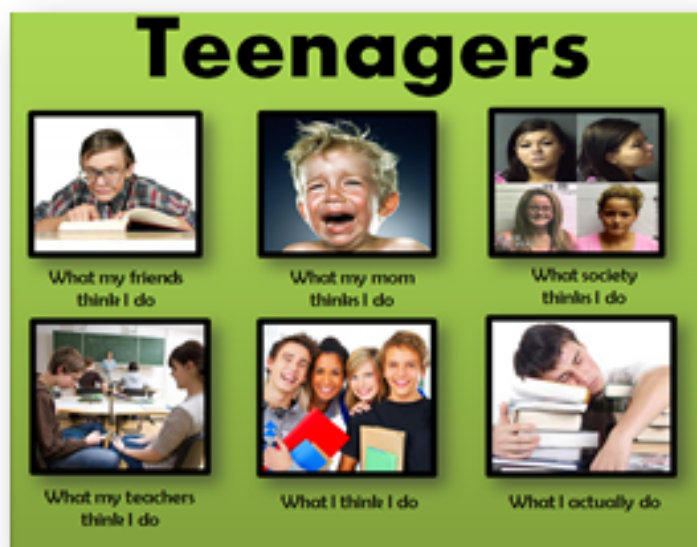
You will showcase your understanding of the subject matter by completing the “What People Think I Do” meme.

What is a Meme?

A humorous image, video, piece of text, etc. that is copied (often with slight variations) and spread rapidly by Internet users.

Directions:

1. Using the “What They Think I Do” descriptors provided for each of the 6 boxes draw a picture or copy and paste a picture that would have a connection to that phrase.
2. If your handout is not provided with the descriptors you will need to create meaningful “What They Think I Do” sayings for each of the 6 boxes that will showcase your understanding of the subject matter.
3. Make sure you understand your subject fully when creating/finding images that you choose
4. In the rectangles to the right of your meme you will explain the symbolism/meaning behind each of your images. Your explanation should be detailed and in complete sentences. This is how the teacher will know if you truly understand the subject matter.
