Decade/era Project

The 20th Century was a period of change in America, and the world. The discoveries, events, and breakthroughs made the course of the world alter drastically. You will create a presentation that highlight the events, people, places, and culture of a chosen decade/era/era that we have studied over the course of this year. (We started with Reconstruction and ended with the US joining World War II.) You should use this sheet as a guide to completing your project successfully. Example website.

Your project will need to include the following information about your decade/era/era:

- Important world events during your decade/era
- U.S. Politics (Who the presidents were, changes in laws, amendments to the constitution, etc.)
- Conflicts or Wars throughout the world during your decade/era
- Inventions, Discoveries, and Technology of your decade/era
- Pop Culture Fads (a widespread enthusiasm for something), clothing, music, media (movies, books), and sports information of your decade/era
- The 3 most influential people of your decade/era (and why you think they are the most influential)

This project will be completed by creating a PowerPoint presentation. The PowerPoint must be at LEAST 10 slides long to receive full credit. If you'd rather create a website instead of PowerPoint, that would be very acceptable. Follow the rubric below to learn more about the grading process:

Presentation	Presentation is easy to see and read, and at least 10 slides were used.	Presentation is fairly easy to read, and 7-9 slides were used.	Presentation is hard to read, and/or less than 7 slides used.

<u>Project requirements</u>: for full credit, you will need to have a PowerPoint presentation that includes all of the following:

- at least 3 major world events that occurred during your decade/era
- the U.S. presidents that were in office during your decade/era
- Any major changes in laws during your decade/era
- Any changes to the constitution that happened during your decade/era
- 2 important conflicts or wars during your decade/era (does not have to be U.S. wars)
- 3 major discoveries or inventions during your decade/era
- Description of what kind of technology was used during your period (any electronics or equipment)
- The type of clothing people wore during your period (description and picture)
- The type of music people were into in your decade/era (and who the popular artists were)
- Any big movies or books that were popular
- Important sports information from your decade/era
- 3 influential (most important) people of your decade/era, and why they are important
- At LEAST 10 pictures (pictures of the world events, wars, presidents, inventions, clothing, and influential people should be done)
- PRESENTATION MUST BE EASY TO READ!

Pictures

Yes, you can use Google image search to find pictures. Just make sure they make sense with your presentation. You don't want pictures of a 1920's gangster holding a laptop (they weren't invented yet!)

Pictures: you can simply copy and paste pictures into your PowerPoint by right clicking the picture, selecting "Copy", then pasting it into the program you are using.
