

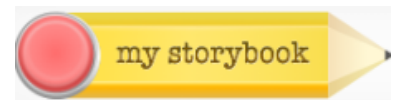
Immigration Storybook

Background:

From 1880-1920, 23 million immigrants arrived in the United States. Each and every person coming to the U.S. had their own story. Your assignment today is to write a child's storybook (for ages 7-12) about immigration. Even though you are going to be writing a fictional story, you MUST include historical facts.

Directions:

- Read through the information provided to you on the immigration experience.
- Flip this sheet over to the back and complete the **brainstorming sheet**. This is meant to ensure that you are including all of the relevant information you need to make a good story.
- Then, browse through the pictures that I have provided. You must choose **at least 6** of those pictures to include in your story (insert them by clicking on Items > Add your image). You may use more than that, and you may incorporate pictures from other sources...but you still must include at least 6 of the ones that I have provided.
- Use <https://www.mystorybook.com/> to create your storybook.
- When you are ready to turn in your story, you need to upload it to **Google Classroom**. Include a comment when you upload detailing the names of all the contributors.



Grading:

This is a FORMAL grade. Your grade will be based on the provided rubric. Read through the rubric to make sure you are familiar with the expectations and can achieve the grade that you want to achieve.

Research:

You should use the internet to find additional information regarding American immigration besides the provided packet. This will help you with your needed details for your story as well as building a well-rounded story. You need to include all the sources you found in your works-consulted page at the end of your story.
