U.S. FOREIGN POLICY IN ASIA

- THE OPEN DOOR POLICY
- CALLED FOR AN EQUAL COMMERCIAL OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL NATIONS TRADING WITH CHINA AND FOR PRESERVATION OF CHINA'S INDEPENDENCE.
- <u>BOXERS</u> TRIED TO DRIVE ALL FOREIGNERS OUT OF CHINA IN 1900
- ROOSEVELT RECEIVED NOBEL PEACH PRIZE FOR THE <u>TREATY OF</u> <u>PORTSMOUTH</u> SETTLING THE JAPANESE-RUSSO WAR IN 1905







OPEN DOOR POLICY'S PURPOSE TO PRESERVE TRADING OPPORTUNITIES IN CHINA FOR ALL FOREIGN NATIONS EQUAL TRADE FOR ALL NATIONS IN CHINA





OPEN DOOR POLICY'S EFFECTS

- CHINESE REBELS KNOWN AS "BOXERS" WANTED TO GET RID OF ALL FOREIGNERS FROM CHINA
- STARTED A REBELLION KNOWN AS THE BOXER REBELLION
 - ATTACKED CHRISTIAN MISSIONARIES AND EMBASSIES
- THE REBELLION WAS CRUSHED
- CHINA WAS CONTROLLED BY FOREIGN COUNTRIES
