U.S. FOREIGN POLICY IN ASIA

- **THE OPEN DOOR POLICY**
- **CALLED FOR AN EQUAL COMMERCIAL OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL NATIONS TRADING WITH CHINA AND FOR PRESERVATION OF CHINA'S INDEPENDENCE.**
- **BOXERS TRIED TO DRIVE ALL FOREIGNERS OUT OF CHINA IN 1900**
- **ROOSEVELT RECEIVED NOBEL PEACH PRIZE FOR THE TREATY OF PORTSMOUTH SETTLING THE JAPANESE-RUSSO WAR IN 1905**

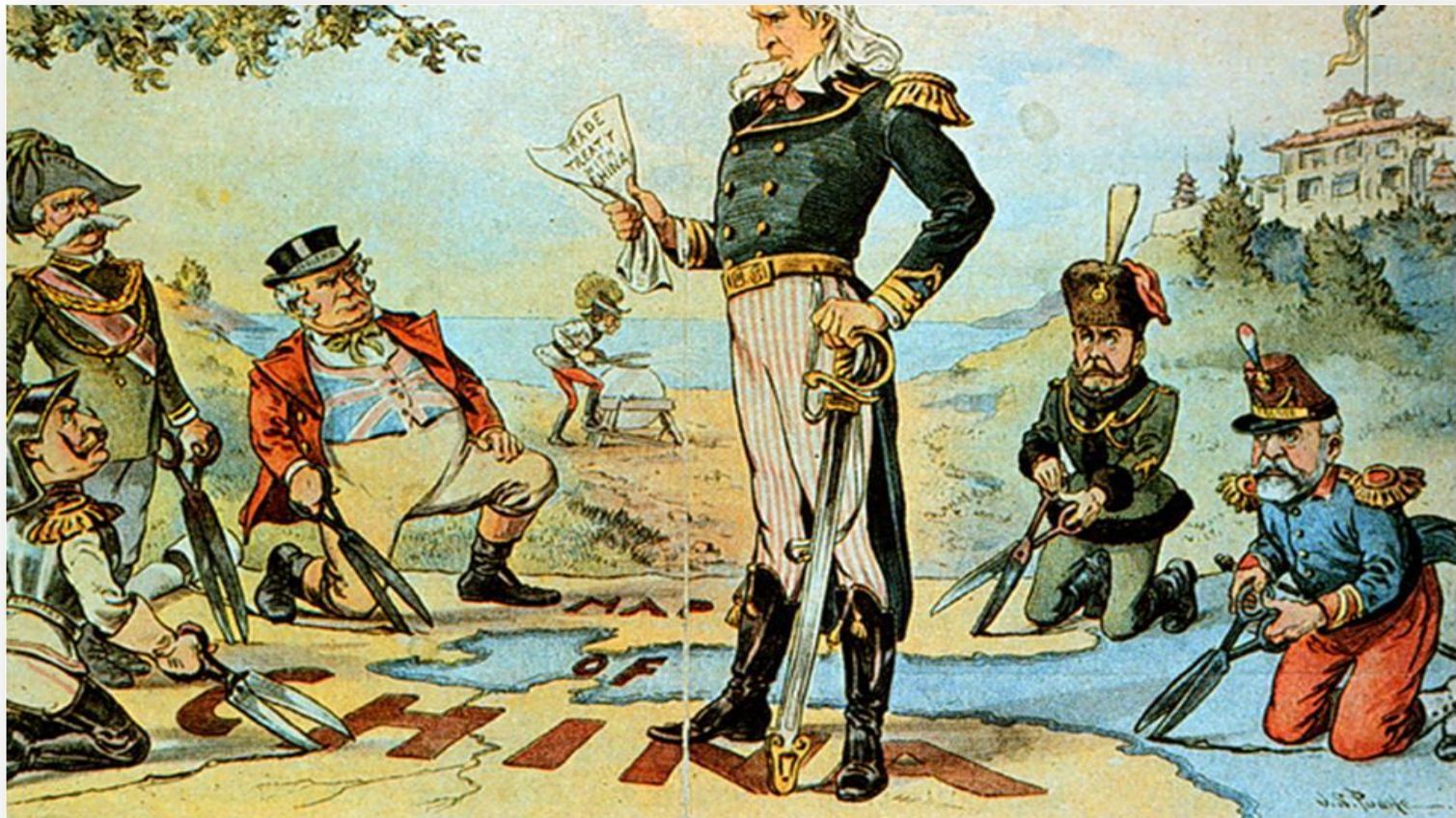

OPEN DOOR POLICY'S PURPOSE

- TO PRESERVE TRADING OPPORTUNITIES IN CHINA FOR ALL FOREIGN NATIONS
- EQUAL TRADE FOR ALL NATIONS IN CHINA



OPEN DOOR POLICY'S EFFECTS

- **CHINESE REBELS KNOWN AS "BOXERS" WANTED TO GET RID OF ALL FOREIGNERS FROM CHINA**
- **STARTED A REBELLION KNOWN AS THE BOXER REBELLION**
 - **ATTACKED CHRISTIAN MISSIONARIES AND EMBASSIES**
- **THE REBELLION WAS CRUSHED**
- **CHINA WAS CONTROLLED BY FOREIGN COUNTRIES**
